# eFORMz Mini-Manual Graphical Charting

# Minisoft eFORMz

#### Version 10.0

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- 1. Only the limited warranties expressly described in this section are made to the Customer purchasing this Product. No warranty of any kind, whether express or implied, is made to any third-party or other transferee or successor of the Customer.
- 2. MINISOFT warrants that it has the right to grant the licenses contained in this Agreement.
- 3. MINISOFT warrants that this product will execute its programming instructions when properly installed on a properly configured computer for which it is intended.
  MINISOFT makes no warranty of any kind, implied or express, that the Product will meet Customer's requirements or that the Product will be uninterrupted or error-free
- 4. MINISOFT, Inc. warrants the media upon which this Product is recorded to be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase. During the warranty period MINISOFT will replace media that prove to be defective. Customer's exclusive remedy for any media that proves to be defective shall be to return the media to MINISOFT for replacement.
- 5. MINISOFT' only obligation, liability and/or remedy, with respect to the warranties set forth in this Agreement shall be one of the following, which MINISOFT shall have sole discretion to choose: (1) as described above, to provide replacement media (whether in the form of the current release or otherwise) for the Product; (2) to replace, without charge, the Product with a functionally equivalent software product; or (3) to refund the applicable license fees paid to MINISOFT by Customer.

These are the sole and exclusive remedies for any breach of warranty.

- 6. MINISOFT shall have no obligation, liability or any other kind of responsibility for the costs of restoring any destroyed or defective data, installation of replacement media, or software conversion work made necessary by replacement media, even if MINISOFT had been specifically informed by Customer of the possibility or probability of any such consequences. During the ninety (90) days warranty period for the media, MINISOFT will replace, without charge, on an exchange basis, any media which is not as warranted. Customer must return the defective item postpaid to MINISOFT, postmarked within the time period stated above. Customer must either insure the defective item being returned or assume the risk of loss or damage in transit. Any claim under the above warranty must include a copy of Customer's receipt or invoice or other proof of the date of delivery.
- 7. Year 2000 Warranty. MINISOFT warrants that the Product will accurately process date/time data (including, but not limited to, calculating, comparing, and sequencing) from, into, and between the twentieth and twenty-first centuries, and the years 1999 and 2000 and leap year calculations, in accordance with the Product's documentation BUT ONLY to the extent that other technology and systems (e.g., software and operating systems, hardware and firmware) used in combination with the Product properly exchanges date/time data with it. In addition to the limitations of liability and remedies described above in this Section, the Year 2000 warranty made herein is made only for ninety (90) days after the date of delivery of the Product and only if any noncompliance is discovered and made known to MINISOFT in writing within such ninety (90) days. The Year 2000 warranty expires after such ninety (90) day period and shall not extend to any events occurring after the expiration date.
- 8. MINISOFT makes no other warranty, expressed or implied, with respect to the Product.
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- 3. No Assignment by Customer. This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of MINISOFT and any successors and assigns. Customer shall have no right to assign or otherwise transfer its rights or obligations under this Agreement except with the prior written consent of MINISOFT, which MINISOFT in its sole discretion and for any reason or no reason provide or withhold.
- 4. Entire Agreement. This Agreement contains the complete understanding between the parties and shall as of the date the Product is first installed supersede all other agreements, whether they are written or oral, between the parties concerning the particular subject matter. The language of this Agreement shall for all purposes be construed as a whole, according to its fair meaning, not strictly for or against either party, and without regard to the identity or status of any person who drafted all or any part of it. No purchase order or any other purchasing instruments issued by Customer, even if such purchase order or other purchasing instrument provides that it takes precedence over any other agreement between the parties, shall be effective to contradict, modify, delete from or add to the terms of this agreement in any manner whatsoever.
- 5. Severability. In the event that any one or more provisions of this Agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable or invalid, then notwithstanding any such finding the remainder of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect, and such provision that is found to be unenforceable or invalid shall be deemed severed.

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
#### Overview

eFORMz Graphical Charting allows users to pictorially display information with bar charts, pie charts and line graphs. These visual depictions of data have numerous advantages for the eFORMz user. First and foremost, they make it significantly easier to understand a company's data. By presenting it illustratively, information is clearer and can be comprehended far more quickly. Additionally, these pictorial representations make it easier to follow trends, sharpening company decision-making. eFORMz Graphical Charting enhances company communications with customers and employees, improving customer service and a company's bottom line.


## Setting Up an eFORMz Project

To become acquainted with eFORMz Graphical Charting:


 Create a new eFORMz Project by right clicking in the Project Window and selecting the New Project option.









3. The Page Properties dialog box will display. Click OK to proceed.



4. To add a Form, right click the new Page and pick the Add Form option.



5. Select Blank as the source of the Form.




6. The Form Properties dialog box appears.


In the Data viewer size field, choose the Fixed option. Increase the Width and Height to accompany the size of the graphs. The default Width is 5760 and the default Height is 7920.

Generally, the Height can remain unchanged and the Width should be adjusted to around 10,000. Directly below that, check the Exclude data box.


Click OK to proceed.









8. Select the data file.








10. Before continuing, save the Project by selecting File > Save Project As.




11. Enter a name and click Save.




#### The Collection of Data

In order to add any graphical representation to a Project, Variables must first be created. To add a Variable:


1. Select the string of characters that will compose the graph with your mouse (left click & drag), right click and pick the Add Variable option.




2. The Variable dialog box will display. Enter a Name that describes the data being picked up and click OK.




3. The Variable will be highlighted in the Input Data Viewer and it will be showing in the Variables Window. It appears that the Variable is only picking up some of the information, and the Variable Window indicates it is grabbing the designated information but not all of it.




4. To remedy this concern, right click the Variable and select Edit.



5. The Variable dialog box will display again. Adjust the # of characters field to the amount that will pick up all of the data for that Variable. To keep things organized, adjust the Vertical position so that it is fully grabbing the given input. The positional numbers are in decipoints. 180 decipoints is the equivalent of 1/4 of an inch.




6. The Variable will now be picking up all of the information.




#### **Delimiters**

For many eFORMz charts, in particular bar charts, the Variable data must be delimited.


 To this Variable, add a comma. Each value must be comma-delimited so as to separate one value from the other. This separation ensures that each value will be graphed as its own piece of data. First, right click the Variable and select Add Function > Replace.




2. The Replace dialog box will display. In the Replace all occurrences of field, enter the characters to replace. To account for spaces, simply enter a few spaces into the field. In the With field, enter a comma. Click OK.




The Replace function will appear below the Variable and the Variable Window will show the changes the function caused.




4. With another string of relevant characters, left mouse click & drag, then right click and pick the Add Variable option.




5. Name the Variable, and adjust the # of characters so that it is grabbing the entire string. In addition, modify the Vertical position so that the Variable will only pick up information from that string.




6. Right click the Variable and select Add Function > Replace.




7. The Replace dialog box will display. In the Replace all occurrences of field, enter the characters to replace. To account for spaces, simply enter a few spaces into the field. In the With field, enter a comma. Click OK.




8. To add another string of information as a Variable, follow the same process. Left mouse click and drag to include as much of the string as possible. Then, right click and select Add Variable.




 Name the Variable, and if necessary, adjust the # of characters field to include all of the information from that string. If any part of the data is not highlighted, as in the previous two examples, modify the Vertical position so that it is completely being picked up.






10. Right click the Variable and select Add Function > Replace.

11. The Replace dialog box will display. In the Replace all occurrences of field, enter the characters to replace. To account for spaces, simply enter a few spaces into the field. In the With field, enter a comma. Click OK.






12. All of the relevant data will be stored as comma-delimited Variables.

### **Bar Charts**

Bar charts are types of graphs which depict different values with rectangular bars. The bars can be vertical or horizontal, but the length of each bar directly corresponds to the value it represents. They are particularly useful for comparing information, such as the amounts or frequency of different characteristics of data. Bar charts also effectively compare multiple data sets. As a result of their clear format, they can be easily processed. Therefore, conclusions about data can be reliably drawn quickly by utilizing eFORMz bar charts.




#### The Placement of a Bar Chart


### Form Template

To place a bar chart with a Rule to be placed on a form:

1. Right click in the Form and Data Viewer and select Add Rule > Bar Chart.




2. Enter a name and select either the Current, Previous or Average Variables created earlier.




#### **Document Template**

To place a bar chart in a Document Template:


1. Right click the form and select Add Document Component > Paragraph.



2. The General tab of the Paragraph Properties dialog box will display. Switch to the Font tab and adjust the font as deemed necessary. When complete, click OK.




3. Right click the Paragraph and select Add chart > Bar chart.




## **Bar Chart Properties**


The Layout tab of the Bar Chart Properties dialog box will display. Adjust the
position, size and insets of the chart as necessary. Good reference sizes for
the Width, Height and Chart insets are those illustrated below. Switch to the
Appearance tab.




2. Enter a title for the chart, or select a Variable for the Chart title field. For the Chart Appearance section, choose a Resolution and whether the chart will be Vertical or Horizontal. For 3D bars, check the 3D button and provide a depth. From the Bar type drop-down menu, pick one of the following options: Stacked bars, Side by side bars, or Bars one behind another. When complete, select the Chart title font and color button.




5. Modify the font and color as needed and click OK. Continue adjusting the font and color of the chart sections as seen fit. Switch to the Data tab.




6. Check the Show samples labels and Show legend boxes, enter 12 for the Sample count and alter the Bar width if desired. From the Samples labels section and Labels field, enter the months of the year as a constant value. From the Data series field, select the New option.



7. The Chart Data Series dialog box displays. In the Series name field, enter "Previous year." Adjust the Bar color by selecting it and changing it accordingly. From the Data drop-down menu, select the Previous Variable created earlier.







8. The series name will be visible in the Data series field. To add another set, select the New option again.

9. Enter "Current year" in the Series name field and adjust the color if appropriate. From the Data drop-down menu, select the Current Variable created earlier. Click OK and select the New option again.



10. Enter "Average" in the Series name field and adjust the color if appropriate. From the Data drop-down menu, select the Average variable created earlier. Click OK.




11. The bar chart will display in the Form and Data Viewer.



## **Gauge Charts**

Also known as dial charts, gauge charts are circular graphs with one or more dials. Each dial has one or more dial sectors, a scale and a needle. A dial sector is used to highlight a certain region on a dial chart with a specific color. For example, a red dial sector for a region could indicate that if the needle is in this region, there is a danger of a supply inventory shortage.




## The Placement of a Gauge Chart


#### Form Template

1. Right click in the Form and Data Viewer and select Add Rule > Gauge Chart.




2. Enter a name and select a Variable.




#### **Document Template**

To place a gauge chart in a Document Template:


1. Right click the form and select Add Document Component > Paragraph.



2. The General tab of the Paragraph Properties dialog box will display. Switch to the Font tab and adjust the font as deemed necessary. When complete, click OK.




3. Right click the Paragraph and select Add chart > Gauge chart.




## **Gauge Chart Properties**






2. Enter a title for the chart, or select a Variable for the Chart title field. For the Chart Appearance section, choose a Resolution. When complete, select the Chart title font and color button.



3. Modify the font and color as needed and click OK. Continue adjusting the font and color of the chart sections as seen fit. Switch to the Data tab.







4. Enter values for the Lower Range and Range fields. From the Data series field, select the New option.

5. The Chart Data Range dialog box displays. In the Range name field, enter the name representing Variable data. In this example, a value of "Current" was entered. Adjust the Bar color by selecting it and changing it accordingly. From the Data drop-down menu, select a Variable created earlier. Click OK.


